

MONTHLY GUEST CAMPSITE RULES AND GUIDELINES

Cleanliness and safety are a top priority for the campground and our guests. Therefore, to ensure that everyone may enjoy their stay please follow the following rules and guidelines regarding your campsite:

ITEMS PERMITTED ON CAMPSITES

Quantity and Details of Items Permitted on Sites:

- (1) Roadworthy and tagged camping unit.
- (2) Tagged and roadworthy vehicle(s). A motorcycle or scooter equals (1) vehicle.
- (1) BBQ grill must be covered when not in use
- (1) Outdoor screen type in good condition. Items must be secure and free of damage such as tears, holes, and missing panels.
- (1) Outdoor furniture sets only. NO indoor furniture of any kind is permitted
- (1) Picnic table.
- (4) Potted Plants: Pots must be clean, presentable, and free of cracks or damage.

Additional Rules:

To keep the park clean and looking its best please adhere to the following:

- Window air conditioners are not permitted in RV units.
- No outside refrigerators, freezers, washers or dryers.
- No under-rig storage. If you are a long-term guest and would like a shed on site (for storage only, no living or laundry allowed in sheds) please refer to the office and they will give you a photo of what is permitted.
- You may have a refrigerator or freezer in your shed as long as you are sub-metered and pay monthly electric.
- Guests must clean their sites and remove non-permitted items.
- All items on site must be clean and in good repair.
- Clutter in general must be removed to adhere to the policy above regarding what is permitted on-site
- Units must be washed to remove mold, mildew, and streaking.
